# Post 16 National Change

- Switch towards linear A Level qualifications  
– all subjects are now linear
- Overwhelming majority of students will choose 3 A levels that they see through to the end of Year 13
- Opportunity for four A Levels if appropriate and if academic excellence at GCSE is demonstrated
- Core Maths an additional option in Year 12 and EPQ in Year 13

- External conditional offers – Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020
- Finalise individual subject choices during March at Course Guidance Meetings (CGM's)
- Induction Day – either Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> or Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June
- GCSE results day – Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August
- Upload results asap, but no later than 3:00pm on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August
- If you do not get a conditional offer and want to come to NSB please go on the Waiting List and upload your results as places always become available
