ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE REMIT

The composition of the Admissions Committee is:

Up to 7 Governors (one of whom will chair)
Senior Staff Convenor in attendance

The Admissions Committee will meet five times per academic year in;

Term 2 (after the Open Evening);

Term 3 (after submission of Year 7 Admission names to the LA and the Sixth Form Open Evening);

Term 4 (after parents are notified of Y7 school places);

Term 6 (after admission appeals);

August (following the GCSE results).

The quorum for Committee meetings is 3 Governors.

The Admissions committee will:

- I. Implement any changes in legislation concerning admissions to secondary schools.
- II. Recommend an agreed admissions procedure for Northampton School *for Boys* to the full Governing Body.
- III. Monitor the application of the admissions policy by senior management at the school to ensure the process is fair and equitable.
- IV. Recommend and monitor the application of an Appeals procedure to comply with current legislation.
- V. Monitor the number of applications to the school from each school for Y7 and Y12 admissions.
- VI. Monitor the successful applications in terms of ethnic and minority groups.
- VII. Ensure the school roll is maintained at appropriately stable levels.
