Re: Kayleigh’s Love Story

You may have heard about this short video that has been taken into schools, firstly in Leicestershire and now throughout Northamptonshire by RISE. The film highlights the dangers of internet use in relation to online grooming and child sexual exploitation. In a world which is becoming increasingly technological and where there is easy access to the internet for young people, including social media, it is necessary to educate young people about how to keep safe.

To support the screening of the film the RISE Team bring with them a CSE Nurse (Child Sexual Exploitation), and RISE Police representative, who deliver a short message before showing the film. The representatives then make themselves available afterwards if there are any questions or queries.

If the clip was to be shown in a cinema it would be rated 15. However, because it is part of a structured approach to creating greater safety online where students will be able to discuss any issues it has been taken into schools for pupils from Year 7 upwards. We are planning to offer students from Year 7 through to Year 10 the opportunity to watch this on Tuesday 4th July but are providing you with the link so that you can watch the short film first and if you feel that you do not want your child to participate then you can let us know by returning the slip below.

The slip only needs to be returned if you **do not** want your son to participate in this online safety session.
