Enterprise Week - OCTOBER 2019

Each year in October the school runs an Enterprise Week where the normal timetable is suspended and each year group engages in a range of activities which complement the normal curriculum run throughout the rest of the year.

For Year 12 there are three options: a Residential Educational visit to an outdoor pursuits centre in Swanage, Work Experience or assisting with Enterprise Week here at school (limited places).

Year 12 students are openly invited to attend the residential to Swanage and we encourage as many Year 12 students to take part as possible. It is an ideal opportunity for all students internal and external to socialise and make new friends. Last year 234 students seized this opportunity and had an incredible time. Past students have often stated that friendships and memories made during this week have been some of their greatest shared memories of the Sixth Form at NSB.

The trip to Swanage is a 5 day residential where students will be able to participate in Large Paddle Boarding, Raft Building, Bush Craft, Sea Kayaking, Team Games, Survival Skills and Coasteering, as well as a range of other activities. Many of the activities will be sea/water based. Activities will continue into the evening with an opportunity to visit to a large Water Park and go Tenpin Bowling as well as team games.

The cost of the trip is **£360**. If you wish to be **considered** for a place on this trip, please send in a deposit of **£100** (applicable to current NSB students) by **Friday 12 July 2019**.

*Staff will make the final decision on whether you will be allocated a place on the residential, if a place is withdrawn due to poor conduct / behaviour a full refund will be issued.

For current NSB students, please use the Parent pay system at school to pay the deposit.

2nd Payment £130 by Friday 20 September 2019

3rd Payment £130 by Monday 14 October 2019

If you do not take up your place in September, you will of course receive a full refund of your deposit.

Students who are in receipt of free school meals or other financial assistance may be eligible for help with the costs of this trip. Please indicate on the reply slip.

External students will need to make the first payment of **£130** via Parent Pay during the second week in September at Northampton School for Boys. (This will allow for registration set up on the payment system).

2nd Payment £230 Monday 14th October 2019

The deadline for securing a place on this trip is **Friday 20th September 2019**, <u>no places will be</u> <u>granted after this date</u>.

Any student not wishing to take part in the trip to Swanage Trip will be expected to organise a Work Experience placement in conjunction with our Careers Advisor or assist with Enterprise Week events for the lower school.
