Travel to Swanage - coach will depart Sports Hall Car Park at **08:00 on Tuesday 11**. Please make sure you arrive no later than **07:45 outside the Swimming Pool**. Parents, can I ask that you drop your son off at the normal location, then students can make their own way down to the car park. Please do not attempt to drive onto the school site.

Students will need the usual toiletries/wash kit, warm clothing, waterproof jacket (essential – they will not travel without one) and suitable footwear as they will be outside during the daytime for the three days we are there. A small bag/rucksack for daily use whilst out is also recommended. Bedding will be provided but students will need to bring **towels** with them. Students will also need to bring a packed lunch for **Tuesday 11 September** for the journey down.
