## Venue

- Examinations take place in the Sports Hall for Yr11 and The Old Gym for Y13, except where stated otherwise. Students with Access Arrangements may take examinations elsewhere. Individuals will be informed.
- Expressive Arts Assessments take place in classrooms.
- Mobile phones and 'Smart' watches are not allowed in the examination or assessment room. Students must hand these in to Student Services before going to registration.

## Start Times

Morning exams start at 09:00am. Afternoon exams start at 1:30pm for A Levels and 2:00pm for GCSE. There will be no registrations on exam days. Students should arrive at the examination room 15 minutes before the start.

#### **IMPORT NOTICE – MOBILE PHONES AND EXAMINATIONS**

### **Exam Board Regulations**

The Joint Council for General Qualifications rules that govern the administration of public examinations state that:

"You must not take into the exam room: potential technological/web enabled sources of information such as an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player, a smartwatch or a wrist watch which has a data storage device". Ear Pods are also prohibited.

This is irrespective of whether these devices are switched on or off. If a candidate is found in possession of any such devices (including in their bag), we are obliged to report this to the awarding body. The candidate may then be disqualified from the current exam and the overall qualification.

#### Northampton School for Boys Arrangements

To comply with this regulation, we insist that all mobile phones (or other prohibited devices) are handed in to Student Services before every examination.
