<u>Symphony Orchestra</u> will perform in **Symphony Hall, Birmingham,** on **Thursday 4 July** from 11 a.m. for an hour. Everyone who is a member of the ensemble is expected to take part. This is our last performance of the year and will follow on from our final school concert performance on **Thursday 27 June – 'Summer Fiesta!'.** 

We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 7 a.m. (although this could be a bit later when we know what time our soundcheck is) and should arrive back at school by 2 p.m. when students will be expected to return to class in school uniform. Casual clothes can be worn to travel in but please bring black concert clothes to perform in, along with plenty of food, or money to buy some with, and water.

Rehearsals will restart from Monday 3 June although Year 11, 12 & 13 examinations must take priority. We would, however, appreciate members of those year groups attending as often as their examination/revision schedule allows them to.
