Dear Parent/Guardian

Covid Vaccination for 12-15 Year Old Children

The School Aged Immunisation Service (SAIS) recently visited your child's school to offer the Covid-19 vaccination. If your child missed this opportunity to be vaccinated at school by the SAIS and you would like your child to receive the vaccine, you can now make an appointment for your child's vaccination at a one of the county vaccination sites.

You will already have received information on the vaccine from the SAIS and we draw your attention to this leaflet on the topic. We would like you to read with and talk to your child about the information in the leaflet specifically for Children and Young People which can be found on the government website.

When you attend a vaccination centre there will be a clinician, either a Doctor, Nurse or Pharmacist who will be happy to answer any additional questions before your child receives their vaccination.
