


## Exam timetables

- Take seats quickly, do not write anything, open booklets, or interact with anybody




Exams will finish at various times, there may still be students sitting exams in the Sports Hall – Remain silent until you <u>LEAVE</u> the Sports Hall building

- It is your responsibility to know the rules, so please check this information carefully




