Dear Parents/Carers,

Please accept this short letter as an outline of recent information given to students about their upcoming GCSE Examinations.

This week, students will have received their provisional GCSE examination timetables. Please take time to carefully check the following:

1. Examination Entries

Ensure your son has been entered for the correct qualifications and subjects. This would include the tier of entry for Maths, Languages, and Science. Any queries regarding these should be discussed with your son's Form Tutor.

2. Personal Details

Check that all personal information (especially full legal name and date of birth) is accurate. Any amendments must be reported within the next **four weeks**. Please note that any changes may incur a cost if examination boards have not been informed in advance. Access Arrangements

Access arrangements (such as extra time) should already be confirmed where appropriate. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs Spencer or Mrs Cleaver.

If your son has a clash of examinations, please do not worry. This is a common scheduling issue. I have spoken to all Year 11 in assembly and students affected by this, and the resolution for any clashes will be evident on their finalised timetable.

More comprehensive information about examinations will be shared later this term.
