



## Results Day Information – GCSE and A-Level Students

Dear Students,

We are writing to provide you with important information about your upcoming Results Days.

- **A-Level Results Day – Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August**
- **GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August**

On both Results Days, the school will be open from **9:00am** for students who wish to attend in person. Your results will also be sent to you via email at **10:00am**.

Within the results pack that you receive on the day, there will be a **yellow Access to Scripts form**. This form allows the school to request copies of your examination scripts from the exam boards. We ask that all students complete and return this form, as it enables the school to review scripts where appropriate and support you with any queries regarding your results.

### GCSE Results Day

If you have applied for the Sixth Form at Northampton School for Boys, you will receive a slip in your results day pack regarding your application. You will be informed that:

- You have successfully met the entry requirements, and your place has been confirmed.
- You have not met the subject-specific requirements. In this case, you will need to attend a meeting with a member of the Senior Leadership Team or Sixth Form Team to discuss the options available to you.
- You have not met the minimum Sixth Form entry requirements. If this applies to you, members of the Careers Team will be available to provide advice and guidance about alternative post-16 pathways and options.

### A-Level Results Day

You may already have received an update from UCAS regarding the outcome of your university application. If your university application has not been successful, members of the Sixth Form Team will be available in the Sixth Form Study to support you with the UCAS clearing process and discuss your next steps. Please note that this support service will be available from **8:00am** on Results Day.

Students who have applied for apprenticeships and wish to discuss their results in relation to offers, explore alternative opportunities, or seek advice on their next steps are also encouraged to speak to a member of the Sixth Form Team.

We appreciate that Results Days can feel exciting, and sometimes stressful, but please remember that support will be available from staff throughout the day. Whatever your results, we are here to help you make the right decisions about your next steps.

We wish you the very best of luck and look forward to celebrating your achievements with you.
