YEAR 12 INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS AND STUDY LEAVE 2026

Dear Parent/Carer

Year 12 (internal) End of Year Exams take place between Monday 27th April and Wednesday 6th May. This is the third week after the Easter Holidays. The exam timetable is shown on at the end of this letter. All these exams take place in the Sports Hall, unless otherwise stated.

Year 12 Study Leave starts from 3.35pm on Friday 24th April. **Students return to lessons on Thursday 7th May.** During this time your son/daughter should study at home, except when required to attend for exams.

Please note the start times in the morning (09:00am) and afternoon (13:30pm); students should arrive 15 minutes prior to these times. Students will have personalised timetables that identify their specific exams, and the seat they will be located in for the examination. This will also be available on EduLink.

BTEC (Sport) students do not have study leave at this time and should attend all lessons as normal.

Year 12 Further Maths students are expected to complete the End of Year Examinations for all of their A-Level subjects, ahead of their external Mathematics examinations (3/6/26).

Whilst on study leave, please encourage your son/daughter to:

- revise thoroughly before the exams.
- check their exam timetable every day to ensure that they do not miss an exam.
- use the school's online resources to access revision tasks set by teachers.

Unauthorised items: are not allowed in any examination rooms. This includes mobile phones, smart watches or wireless earpods. We recommend that all such devices are left at home on exam days, however, if any parent believes that it is important that their son or daughter has a mobile phone with him at school, then the phone **MUST** be handed in to Student Services, prior to the start of the exam.

Failure to adhere to the regulations of the examination will result in disqualification, with appropriate sanctions, where necessary. More information regarding examinations can be found on the school website [here](#).
