Timetable

Year 12 Further Maths students will have TWO examinations:

- Monday 5th January 09:00-11:00
- Tuesday 6th January 13:30-14:30

Students should arrive for examinations at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.

Venue and Conduct

- All examinations will be held in the Sports Hall, unless otherwise stated. Students with approved Access Arrangements will be informed of their alternative locations.
- To replicate the demands of the summer examinations, and in line with JCQ regulations, no "potential technology/web-enabled sources of information" are permitted in the exam room.
- Candidates must not have in their possession:
 - Mobile phones
 - Smart watches or watches of any kind
 - o AirPods, earphones, or earbuds
 - MP3/4 players or similar devices
- Possession of any of the above items will be reported as malpractice and may lead to penalties. This is in accordance with JCQ Suspected Malpractice: Policies and Procedures (1 Sept 2025).
- Students are strongly advised not to bring such devices onto site during the exam period. If essential, they must be handed into Student Services before the start of an exam

Study Leave

Students studying Further Maths in Year 12 will be on study leave on 5th and 6th of January and are only expected to be in school for examinations. Outside of these examinations, students should revise and prepare for upcoming papers. All Year 12 Further Maths students are expected to return to lessons on Wednesday 7th January.

Access Arrangements and Special Consideration

- Students eligible for Access Arrangements (e.g., extra time or separate rooms) will have these confirmed in advance.
- If you believe your child may require support not already in place, please contact Mrs Cleaver (Access Arrangements Administrator) or Mrs Spencer (SENDCo) immediately.
- Special Consideration is a post examination adjustment to a candidate's mark or grade to reflect temporary injury, illness or other indisposition <u>at the time of the examination</u>/assessment.
 - Special Consideration may be applied if circumstances (e.g., illness or bereavement) affect performance.
 If such an issue arises, please contact the Exams Office immediately after the exam, providing any relevant documentation.
