NSB took a team of 14 rowers to London, 9 boys came home with medals.

Tadiwa Ziwenga claimed a bronze medal in the Year 7 SEND category in his first ever competition!



Jack Jackson-Parish (Yr 9) took the bronze for his 4-minute race and Max Roper (Yr 10) took the silver for his 5-minute race. In his final year at NSB, Cade Sivil (Yr 13) took the bronze in the 2000m.

We have achieved some notable success at NJIRC in previous years in the relays, and this year was no different. Ben Jones kindly left his post-rugby cup final celebrations early to join the rowing squad. His efforts paid dividends with the senior lads claiming gold over 2112m, in a time of 6:01.8. This team was comprised of Cade Sivil (Yr 13), Ben Jones (Yr 12), Max Roper (Yr 10) and Will Brightman (Yr 10).



The junior relay squad took bronze with a time of 6:49.9. This team was comprised of Jesse Sivil (Yr9), Monty Leahy (Yr 8), Jack Jackson-Parish (Yr 9) and Jacob Adiamah (Yr9).



For experience, we entered a team of Year 7 boys, to compete against the Year 9's. They managed a very respectable 33rd, with a time of 8:17.2. I have high expectations for these lads going forward. They are Zac Maule, Xander Tilley, Charlie Auburn and Bradley Feasey. All of these boys are currently found lingering in the top ten of the world leading sprint times for their age group this season over 100m and 500m.
