YEAR 12 INTERNAL SUMMER EXAMINATIONS AND STUDY LEAVE 2023

Internal End of Year exams start on Monday 5th June and finish on Tuesday 13th June 2023. The exam timetable is shown below. All of these exams take place in the Old Gym except where stated. The exam period will take place over seven school days not ten as previously indicated in the school calendar.

Year 12 study leave for these Internal End of Year exams starts from 3.35pm on Friday, 26th May (the beginning of the half-term holiday) with **all students returning to lessons on Wednesday 14th June.** During this time your child should study at home, except when required to attend for exams.

Please note the start times in the morning (09:00am) and afternoon (13:30pm); students should arrive 10 minutes prior to these times so they can enter the Old Gym (or alternative exam room) and get themselves settled before the start of the paper. They should go directly to the exam hall or classroom where they are taking the paper. Students must bring the necessary equipment for each paper, including a black pen. Subject teachers can offer more advise about equipment students should bring, including calculators.

BTEC (Sport) students do not have study leave at this time and should attend all lessons as normal.

If your son or daughter has an exam clash, they will be advised by email of the time they will take the second paper. They should look out for this in their NSB account and reply to it, so that we know they have the correct information. This is especially important for Geography students who, because of their fieldtrip studies in week two of the exams, will sit all of their papers in the first week.

Whilst on study leave, please encourage your child to:

- revise thoroughly before the exams.
- check their exam timetable every day to ensure that they do not miss an exam.
- use the school's online resources to access revision tasks set by teachers.

Mobile phones: Please note that mobile phones or any device capable of receiving and/or storing data are not allowed in any examination rooms. This includes all wireless ear pods. All watches are banned from the Exam Hall. We recommend that all such devices are left at home on exam days, however, if any parent believes that it is important that your child has a mobile phone with them at school, then the phone <u>MUST</u> be handed in to Student Services, prior to the start of the exam. We do not advise leaving them in the changing room areas as these are not locked, nor staffed during the exams.
