Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Final Details for Ski Trip to Italy – 18th to 25th February 2024

Considering the recent developments on the ski trip, I write to outline important information regarding departure, accommodation, and journey details. Please read very carefully.

To confirm, we are now flying to the resort in Italy, which will save us 12 hours of transfer time on the way there and the way back, with no extra cost.

Travel Arrangements:

Outward journey

- Meet at NSB sports hall car park at 2:00am on Sunday 18th February 2024.
- Parents/Guardians are requested to park at the front of school, the Old Northamptonians or in nearby streets and walk down the access road with luggage as there will not be enough space for 3 coaches and 120 cars.
- Depart NSB at 2:30am on 18th February 2024 from the sportshall car park. Transfer arranged by Select School Travel.
- Arrive Birmingham airport 3:30am, check in from 4:00am.
- Jet2 Flight leaves at 7:00am and arrives in Turin at 10:05am (local time).
- Arrive Hotel Marguareis, Artesina at 1:30pm approx. Coach transfer to Artesina via local coach arranged by Select School Travel.

Return journey

- Stay the extra night on evening of 24th February 2024 in Hotel Marguareis and/or other local hotel.
- Depart Artesina 05:30am (approx.) on 25th February 2024 Transfer from resort by local coach to Turin airport.
- Fly back to Birmingham at 11:05am arriving 12:00pm then transfer from Birmingham Airport to NSB, leaving at 1:00pm approx. arriving at NSB at 2:30pm approx.

Day of Departure and Outbound Journey

- It is vital that each student brings their passport and GHIC/EHIC. Students who need extra documentation for any reason must bring that too.
- Students' main bags must not exceed 22kgs. Please check the weight of your son/daughter's bag before you arrive at school. Students will be responsible for any additional fees charged by Jet2.
- Hand luggage bags must not exceed the dimensions 56x45x25cms and must not weigh more than 10kg.
- Please refer to the Jet2 website for further information regarding luggage restrictions.
- The rules for what can and cannot be in hand luggage are as follows:
- No sharp items.
- No aerosols.
- No liquids over 100ml. This includes toothpaste. If in doubt pack it in your stowed luggage.
- Electrical items should be in your hand luggage so they can be inspected.
- The target departure time is 2.30am, but if we are all settled and ready to go prior to that time, it is possible we could depart a little earlier.
- Parents/Guardians are reminded that once in resort the trip is full board, and our first meal in resort is a hot lunch on the Sunday when we arrive. For this reason, students will need some form of packed breakfast or some money in Sterling and Euros to cover breakfast. However, please note that we cannot take drinks through security as they will be over 100ml.
- Please ensure that your son/daughter brings a re-usable water bottle.
- We require all students to wear their NSB ski hoodie for the outbound and return journeys. This will aid
 group supervision when we are in transit. It is however possible that you will not have your hoodie until
 the day of departure.
- As stated earlier, it is vital that Parents/Guardians do not drive down to the sports hall carpark as there
 will not be enough space for an efficient departure. Please park locally then bring students and luggage
 down the access road.
- Students will be reminded of the procedure for checking in and advice about getting through security at Birmingham airport whilst on the coach.

Return to School

- We are due to arrive back at school at approximately 2:30pm on Sunday 25th February. It is normal practice for drop off to occur in the bus bay at the front of school. However, the coach will not be able to use that space if parents pull into the bus bay. For this reason, can we respectfully request that parents park either in the school crescent, in adjoining streets or perhaps at the Old Northamptonians.
- Please be aware that return times are approximate, if our transfer is affected by any unforeseen circumstances that will significantly alter our arrival time to school, we will have the students call home to inform you of this.

IMPORTANT TRAVEL INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- **VERY IMPORTANT** Make sure that your son has his **PASSPORT** and **GHIC/EHIC** card with him, in a zipped pocket in his travel clothes, which they can reach easily in transit, do not pack in stowed luggage!
- **Passports** please note that we will collect all passports after we have arrived in Italy and hold these centrally for the duration of the trip. They will be returned to students to board the return flight on the return journey.
- Global Health Insurance Card/European Health Insurance Card the students must ensure they bring an up-to-date GHIC/EHIC with them on the trip. Students will be instructed to carry the card with them daily on the slopes in a secure jacket pocket.
- The Coach Company has asked that bags should be a soft hold-all type as space in the baggage compartment is limited. Large, rigid suitcases will be difficult to pack.
- Trip updates will be posted on X (Twitter), (depending on local Wi-Fi!) on the @NSBsport account.

- If any families have outstanding finances on the balance of payments, could we request that these are cleared in full prior to the date of departure. If this is problematic, could we ask you to contact the trip leader at the school to discuss the matter.
- Please ensure that your child brings a towel.
- In your hand luggage, make sure you pack the following:
- 1. Food for the journey (**no chewing gum, fizzy drinks, or sweets please**). Reminder drinks over 100ml cannot go through airport security.
- 2. **No student is to bring nut based or shellfish snacks on the buses**, given the fact there are students with allergies travelling with us.
- 3. Money (both Euro's and a small amount of sterling for outbound and return trip). For pocket money I advise around €10 a day as a rough guide, but this is entirely your choice and be assured that all meals are provided in resort.
- 4. Book/magazine/games or other entertainment, but please remember smart phones/ipads etc are taken at your own risk.
- 5. **Medication VERY IMPORTANT** If you have a medical condition, and need regular medication please ensure that both your Trip Leader and Travel Group Leader (if they are different people) know of the condition and the medication. As a rule of thumb, if your medication involves anything beyond a salbutamol inhaler for asthma, your travel group leader will take responsibility for your medication. Please hand this over at coach departure in an envelope clearly marked with name, medication and details of how to administer.
- Students can ask their travel group leader to look after their money on the trip. Responsibility will not be accepted for any loss of money from students who decide to manage their own finances during the trip.
- Please use the following as a guide for ski kit:

Travel	comfortable loose clothing, including NSB Ski Hoodie
	packed breakfast – absolutely no fizzy drinks, sweets, chewing gum, nuts, shellfish
	Passport/EHIC or GHIC/Euro's/medication as necessary.
Evenings	It will be cold in resort but we will rarely go out after skiing.
	Warm, casual clothing to be worn around the hotel.
	Beanie or bobble hat (NSB ski bobble hat supplied)
	2 pairs of footwear - 'clean' for the hotel
	- dirty' for the boot room/evening excursions.
Skiing	2 or 3 pairs of ski socks, much underwear
	A pair of skiing gloves (woolen gloves are no good, they stay wet + cold)
	Base layer - thin long sleeve top or t-shirts. Thermal leggings if it is very cold
	You could bring thermal top/under armour style base layer
	Light middle layer - long sleeve top / extra t-shirt
	Top Layer - ski trousers/salopettes and ski jacket
	Head - helmet provided, eyewear, either sun glasses or goggles
	Small rucksack for extra clothing, snack and water
General	You will need a Towel
	Wash bag and toiletries
	Nightwear
	Suncream and lip salve
	Game/magazine/books etc. for rooms
	You are advised to bring a bin liner to pack damp clothes on the day of return
	Please bring a face mask
	Italian plug adapter – make sure it is the right one!
Reminder	We supply skis, poles, ski boots and helmet.
