RE: SAFIB U14 Boys International Football Festival Allen McKinstry Cup, May 2025 Newcastle-Upon-Tyne

Following our success in reaching the ESFA U13 National Finals last year, we have been invited to represent England at the prestigious U14 Allen McKinstry Cup, in Newcastle in May 2025. We will be playing against the champions from Republic of Ireland, Northen Ireland, Scotland and Wales in what was formally known as the British Isles Cup. I've included a possible itinerary with this letter that has been provided by the SAFIB (Schools Association Football International Board).

Dates

Wednesday 14 May 2025, pm matches

Thursday 15 May 2025, am matches

Friday 16 May 2025, am (Finals Day, followed by presentation of medals and trophy)

Cost

Whilst this is a fantastic opportunity for the students to take part in, the trip comes at a considerable cost to the school and as such we will be asking for a **contribution of £160 towards the cost of the trip** to include travel, fixtures, facilities, officials, meals and accommodation across the three days.

Accommodation

All schools will be staying in the Ramada Encore Hotel, Gateshead Quayside – NE8 3AD. Students will be staying in twin rooms with ensuites and staff will be in rooms on the same floor. For safeguarding reasons any supporters are asked to book alternative accommodation elsewhere.

Included Meals

The following meals will be available:

Wednesday – dinner buffet after the games.

Thursday – breakfast, lunch after the games, dinner.

Friday – breakfast before checkout.

Please provide any dietary requirements on the attached form.

Travel Details

We will travel to Newcastle via minibus and students should bring some money or a packed lunch to eat on the way to Newcastle on Wednesday 14 May and have enough money to be able to buy something at the services on the way home on Friday 16 May. Please don't provide them with fizzy drinks or sweets for the bus as we want to avoid travel sickness.
