### Re: Duke of Edinburgh Award

Your son/daughter has shown an interest in enrolling in the Gold Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.

The Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme began in 1956 and is now widely recognised by employers, colleges, universities and the forces as a powerful tool for the personal development of young people.

#### It will involve.

Your son/daughter will have to complete the following five sections over the next 18 months:

- Volunteering
- Skill
- Physical
- Residential
- Expedition

The minimum time requirement for each section is expressed in months during which time they will need to undertake a regular commitment of at least one hour per week. It is expected that the Skill, Volunteering, Physical Recreation and Residential sections will be completed in the student's own time, with some assistance from both the school and parents.

<sup>\*</sup>Note students who have not completed the silver award will need to do a further 6 months of either the Volunteering or the longer of the Skill / Physical Recreation.

Expeditions and training will be co-ordinated through the school using an external company BXM expeditions. This organisation will provide all the training necessary with qualified expedition leaders. Training will be completed in school on a Sunday, students have to attend these dates in order to complete the requirements for the expedition section.

### Dates are as follows:

**Training: Sunday 2 March 2025** 

Practice: Tuesday 22 April 2025 – Friday 25 April 2025 Expedition: Sunday 6 July 2025 – Friday 11 July 2025

All students must to attend both the training, practice and the assessed expedition to complete the expedition section of the award. There will be no other expeditions organised by the school.

There will be a charge of £80.00 for the joining fee, which includes the record book this is non – refundable. There is an additional fee of £518 which includes charges for the training, the practice expedition and assessed expedition all of which are provided by BXM Expeditions, due to the large number of students. They provide the tents and the stoves for each group; other kit will be discussed on the training day. This fee also included transport to and from the expedition locations.
