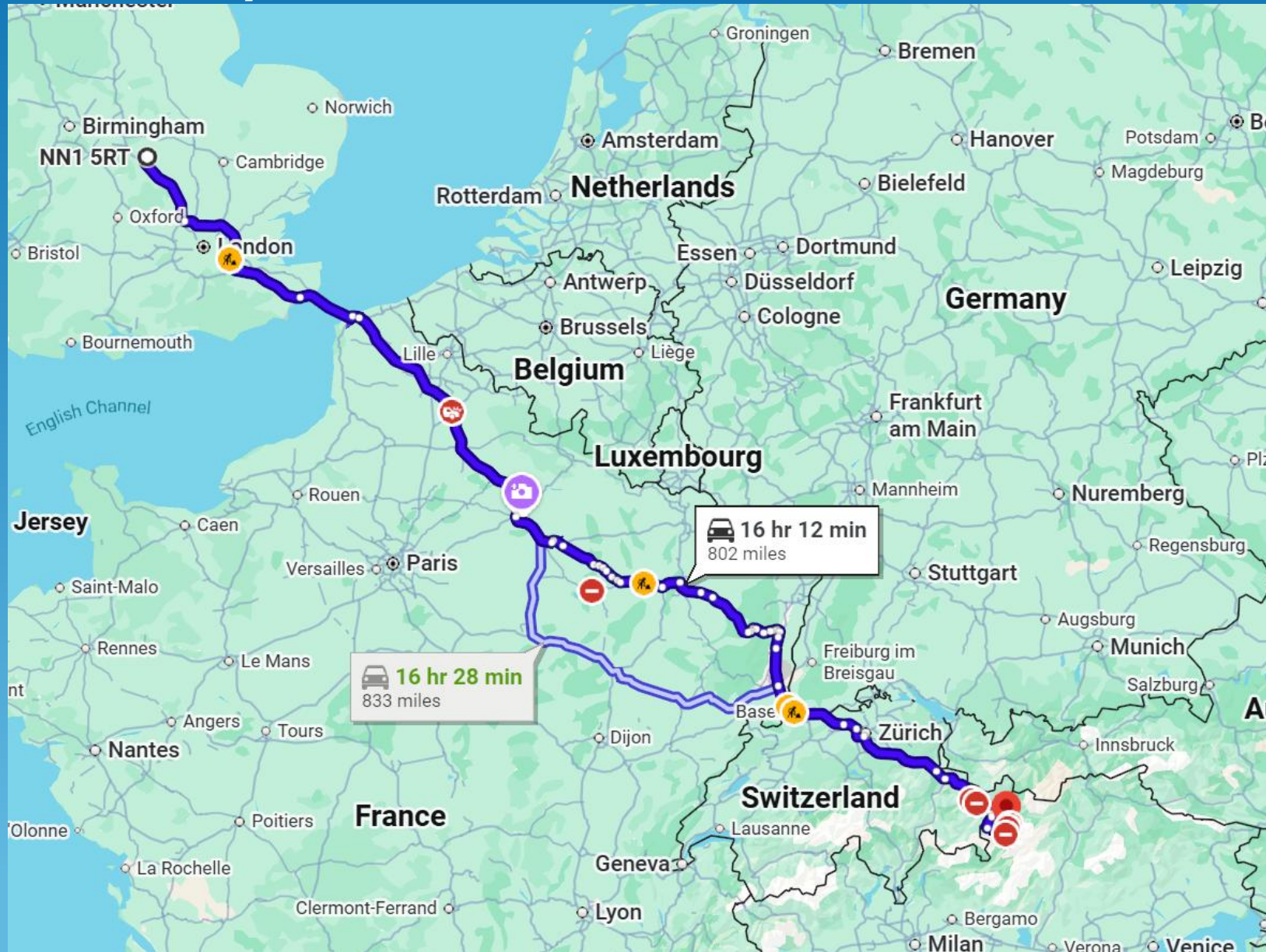

Typical Ski Day

- 07:30 Up, dressed and breakfast.
- 08:30-16:30 Ski Lessons.
- 12:30 Lunch back at hotel.
- 16:30-18:30 Return to Hotel, shower, rest.
- 18:30-21:00 Meal and evening activity.
- 21:30 Bedtime.



Ski Kit

- Ski equipment included in the price are skis, poles, ski boots and helmets – compulsory!!!
- The jacket and trousers/salopettes must be made for skiing.
- What you need on the slopes:
LAYERS! Under ski jacket and trousers, you need leggings (If sun not out), long sleeved T-shirt, fleece/sweatshirt, ski gloves, sun cream and sunglasses/goggles.

Kit List

- Ski suit/jacket/salopettes/trousers.
- Three pairs of ski socks, several changes of underwear.
- A warm fleece.
- HOODIE - ONE IS INCLUDED IN THE PRICE
- WE ALL WEAR IT TO TRAVEL THERE AND BACK!
- Several t-shirts, long and short sleeved.
- Apres ski wear. Jeans, jogging bottoms etc.
- Wash bag and toiletries. Nightwear/ Towels.
- Sun block and lip salve.
- Good quality sunglasses or ski goggles.
- Warm hat and ski gloves.
- One pair of outdoor trainers and one pair of indoor shoes.
- Drink bottle and some bin liners.
- Small rucksack for drink/snack.
- Expensive items are taken **at your own risk.**



Risk Assessment

- Each stage of the trip has been thoroughly risk assessed.

From the coach to resort, on the slopes, après ski and the return.

- However, skiing is a medium risk activity.
- Equivalent to 6 days of PE lessons.
- Contingency plans will be discussed.
- Our RA will be signed off by our visit advisor.

Points Of Good Practice

- Travel groups and buddy system.
- Pocket money. £80 approx. We will run a tuck shop.
- The contact in this country will be available 24 hrs a day to both parents and staff on the trip. Emergency use only.
- On the trip risk assessment will be on-going.
- Pupils to be made aware of emergency plans.
- Information cards.
- Medical/Dietary issues.
- If your son may need medication (other than paracetamol/ibuprofen) on the trip, please pack some with a letter authorising us to administer it.
- Location of staff rooms.



- Pupils' names will be on their doors.
- Contingency fund.
- Parents made aware of destination details, and how to contact their child in case of emergency.



Code Of Conduct

- All pupils must show courtesy and respect to all members of staff, ski instructors, and other adults at all times. They must also behave in a sensible manner.
- Normal school rules apply. In particular due to the nature of the trip it is imperative that pupils follow instructions first time given.
- Pupils must wear seatbelts when on the coach.
- Under no circumstances should pupils ski unsupervised.
- Under no circumstances are pupils allowed to leave the hotel unsupervised.
- All pupils must adhere strictly to any meeting times.
- Pupils must carry their Information card with them at all times.
- Pupils must be responsible for their own safety and that of their buddy, and ensure that they never go anywhere alone.

Administration

To come on the trip, you need the following things:

- An EHIC or GHIC (Global Health Insurance Card)
- It is free so beware sites which charge you
- Google GHIC and follow the .gov or NHS website links
- A valid passport which has a date of expiry longer than 3 months from date of the day we plan to return
- Any visas associated with non British passports.

We also need:

- A completed consent form - Don't worry about kit sizing if they have grown by Feb.
- A EHIC/GHIC copy and passport copy submitted through the Evolve portal.
- Payment! Deadline is end of Term 2 2026



Food

Typically in Italy, and especially in ski resorts, you will be offered the following:

- Breakfast – bread, jam, cheese, ham, eggs, cereal, cake
- Lunch – Pasta of varying types and sauces
- Dinner – Salad, pasta, meat and a vegetable.

Some of the food may be different to what you are used to ie fennel as the vegetable.

YOU MUST EAT – skiing is a tiring activity and if you fuel your body incorrectly, you will get ill. Please try new foods and add some fruit, salad or vegetable at each meal

If you are a fussy eater, please bring carbohydrate based snacks

Final Information

- We will write to you after Christmas confirming the travel arrangements. Specifically, information relating to the day of departure, and destination details.
- NB: The travel company insist that students take one soft holdall type bag - No hard suitcases!
- Communication will largely go through the boys via Teams –please make sure you check on a regular basis
- Please keep up with the payment schedule and let me know if you have any issues
