## Re: A Level Geography Field Studies Trip - Monday 12th June - Friday 16th June 2023

As part of the A Level Geography course, students must undertake field studies. The data collection programme can come from any element of the A Level course; however, the team have chosen two key areas to study which are: -

- 1. Re-branding places
- 2. Coasts Protection/Conflict

The first part of the week will look at different sections of the Jurassic Coastline, firstly, Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door with the primary focus on high/low energy coastlines. Swanage is the next stop, with an emphasis on the use of hard/ soft engineering for protection, before taking a trip to Studland to measure the impact of humans on a psammosere succession. The penultimate day will see the students consider the need for continued regeneration of Boscombe. During the final day students will break into working groups and conduct their own independent fieldwork data collection, which they will then be able to use back at school to produce their independent investigate / coursework.

The field studies week enables a 'hands on' approach to data collection. The main objective for the week is to be able to collect sufficient data to be able to produce the 4000-word individual geographical report. A compulsory element, with a 20% weighting for the entire A Level Geography course.

It is therefore proposed that all A Level Geography students undertake this field studies programme from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in Swanage. I am aware this is during the Sixth Form lesson time, but it has been authorised by the headmaster and, there is the expectation that students catch up on work missed in their other subject areas.

The cost of this field trip which includes four night's full board accommodation, at The Leeson house field studies centre, transportation to and from Swanage plus supporting journeys each day. Additional tutors and equipment throughout the week from the Education Centre **£425**.
