Outward Journey:

Depart NSB on Monday 21 October students to be here from 06:30hrs to leave at 07:00hrs.
Arrive at Centre at 12:00hrs (approx.)

Students must be dropped off opposite the school site and make their way down to the swimming pool car park. **Do not** drive down to the car park, as it will be very busy with 5 coaches and 200+ students in attendance. The first meal will be on Monday evening at the Centre in Swanage so students will require money for the comfort stop at a Service Station or alternatively they can bring a packed lunch if you prefer. No hot food is to be taken on any of the coaches.

Return Journey:

Depart from Centre Friday 25 October at 13:00-13:30hrs – Lunch before departure
Arrive back at NSB at 19:00-19:30hrs (approx.)

The students will be advised to text you ETA's closer to arrival as it is dependent on the Friday evening traffic. Again, we ask that you wait for your child off the school site and do not drive down; they will walk up the access road once they have collected their luggage from the coaches.

Activities

Activities for each group vary, but each group will do a range of activities from the following during the course of the week: -

Coasteering, Large Paddle-Boarding, Sea Kayaking, Raft Building, Archery, Bush Craft, Team Building, Ten Pin Bowling, Water Park.

Only one large holdall style bag per student, plus a small rucksack type bag to take on board the coach is permitted. If students bring valuable items like iPads, mobile phones etc. then they will be responsible for their safety at all times.

Northampton School for Boys – Y12 Swanage School Trip
Behaviour Contract – Monday 21 – Friday 25 October

In order to ensure a safe and successful Sixth Form trip for all, we expect participants to behave in an acceptable and responsible manner. Students are representing themselves and Northampton School for Boys and expectations will be the same as they are in school in relation to behaviour.

Appropriate consequences for failing to adhere to the Behaviour Contract will be decided by the Trip Leader. This may include, for example, an early curfew or being taken off activities. In extreme cases of inappropriate behaviour, the Trip Leader will contact home and request that their child be collected with immediate effect.

Travel:

- Be considerate to those around you and make sure that noise is not of a level that would distract the driver.
- **No** speakers on the coaches.
- Wear your seatbelt at all times; do not stand up or move around the coach while travelling unless to go to the toilet.
- On a comfort break make sure you adhere to times given to return. **Do not bring hot food back onto the coach.**

Harrow House and Social activities:

- Attend all activities, unless medically excused. You will not be able to remain in your room on your own, so report to your group leader.
- **Do not** enter other students' rooms during your stay and remain in your room after a set time each evening (normally 10:30pm).
- **Only you have a key code for your room, don't give this to other rooms.**
- Attend all meals; this residential is physically demanding and you will need energy to get the most out of the trip.
- **Mobile phones** should only be used in your rooms and after 9:00pm in the Common Room areas. Do not take them to activities as they are water based.
- No loud music in rooms – remember it is an international school and there are students boarding there whilst we are present.
- Be punctual at all times.

General:

- Be sensible, courteous and respectful at all times.
- Do not use foul or abusive language.
- Be responsible for your own belongings and respectful of other people's belongings.
- Social media should only be used with permission of students/adults in the photo or video.
- Should there be an incident, you are not to post anything on social media or text others.
- Carry out all instructions from NSB Staff, Harrow House Staff, Coach Drivers and Land and Wave instructors promptly and without fuss.
