Travel to Swanage - coach will depart Sports Hall Car Park at **08:00 on Monday 25**. Please make sure you arrive no later than **07:45 outside the Swimming Pool.** Parents, can I ask that you drop your son off at the normal location, then students can make their own way down to the car park. Please do not attempt to drive onto the school site.
