**Re: Y12 Residential Trip to Bournemouth – 18-22 October 2021**

It is only a few weeks away before the Year 12 students leave for their annual entitlement trip to the Bournemouth. All payments for the residential trip should be paid by the deadline of Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Outward Journey Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021 students should arrive at school **7.00am** on the day of departure, and make their way, with their luggage to the Sports Hall. Please can students walk down the access road, as their normal entrance will be locked. Please can ask that Parents/Carers do not drive down, as 200+ cars and several large coaches it will be chaos. Students must take a LFT prior to arriving at school. If positive, please telephone one of the emergency numbers at the bottom of this letter.

Depart NSB on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October 7.30am. Arrive at Bournemouth at 12.00pm approx. (The coach will make a short stop on route for refreshments and a toilet break.) Remember masks for the coach journey, packed lunch, and money.

The estimated time of arrival back at Northampton *school for boys* on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October is 5.00pm – but this is very much dependent on traffic. Please can I ask that students leave the school in the normal way. Parents /Carers you will need to collect your son/daughter off the school grounds.
