Study Tour to Iceland

We are delighted to offer students a very exciting opportunity. In October half term 2023, Northampton School for Boys will be embarking on an overseas field trip to Iceland. The trip is open to current Year 10 and 12 students and would be of special interest to geographers, although all are welcome.

The 5-day trip running from Tuesday 24th to Saturday 28th October, will be organised by Rayburn Tours, our chosen UK tour operator who specialise in student trips and tailor-made holidays to Iceland and beyond. For your peace of mind, they are a leading UK travel company. They are accredited by the School Travel Forum, an initiative set up to promote best practice and educational travel. The School Travel Forum companies must provide comprehensive safety management standards and operate within the restrictions of a stringent DEFS Code of Practice. Itinerary

During the trip we will visit some of the most spectacular landscapes in the world that now feature in many Hollywood blockbusters. We will visit incredible waterfalls, volcanic craters, lava fields, glaciers, geysers and the site where the European and American plates are pulling the landscape apart. We will also see amazing basalt lava columns in caves by the sea, spectacular gorges, thermal swimming pools, secret lagoon and more. I will be organizing and supervising the trip. The approximate cost of the trip will be £1,250. This may change due to reasons including exchange rates and number of students travelling. The price is currently based on 30 students wishing to participate and includes: Transfers to and from Stansted airport, return flights, all transport in Iceland, a five-day programme of excursions and activities, accommodation in Reykjavik, breakfast, packed lunch and dinner each day, guides and fees for all daytime activities and excursions.

Provisional Itinerary

- Day 1: Pick up from the airport. Time to visit the Reykjanes Peninsula (Bridge Between Continents, Gunnhuver Hot Springs, Krysuvik Mud Puddles).
- Day 2: Secret Lagoon and Golden Circle (Thingvellir, Geysir, Gulfoss).
- Day 3: Hellisheidi Power Plant and South Coast (Seljalandsfoss, Skogafoss, Solheimajokull, black basalt beaches).
- Day 4: Hvalfjordur, Hraunfoss, Bjarnarfoss, Deildarunguhver Hot Springs, free time in Reykavik.
- Day 5: Transfer back to the airport for your flight home.
