## **Restoring lives**

Helping women and families flee from and survive domestic abuse is a vital part of eve's role. But equally important is helping people who have been abused to rebuild their lives and to become functioning members of society again.

Our **Restored Programme** has been developed to help those in our refuge and others in the community to get their lives back on track. Women work towards five outcomes: physical survival, safety and security, social needs and belonging, self-worth and esteem, and meaning and purpose. Each woman has her own development plan and we use a variety of group-work, creative activities, motivational, educational and therapeutic techniques to help them to change their thinking and behaviours, and to move from being victims to being confident, resilient people with a healthy lifestyle.

We also work with the children to help them deal with and overcome their own trauma. Our Children's Services team make close links with families. offering parenting support and therapeutic sessions. They liaise with other agency staff including schools, nurseries and health visitors, accessing additional support and resources as required.

Our SHE Programme is a new project that works with families who are affected by domestic abuse, supporting women and children through our existing services. SHE includes a programme called Fresh Start for male partners and ex/partners who have used controlling and abusive behaviours in their relationships and who wish to change, helping them to recognise the damaging effects of their behaviour. Fresh Start also enables men to understand their roles as parents, helping them to co-parent alongside their partners by developing healthy relationships, whether they choose to remain as a couple or safely separate.

### HOPE

care and support in the initial stages, followed by a structured programme of activities and group work for those survivors looking to rebuild, or change, their lives, and to help them to avoid future abusive relationships.

An integral part of our work is our refuge, which can accommodate 13 single women and families in a supported and secure environment. It also has a ground floor flat for those with accessibility needs.

While our Christian ethos impacts the way that we work, we welcome women from other faiths and those who have no faith; all are accepted and respected. We work very closely with Northamptonshire Domestic Abuse Services, and with other similar women's refuge organisations across the country.
