For those students who are not attending a trip, there will be the opportunity for parents to discuss upcoming Work Experience placements with Naomi Shaeffer (Careers Advisor), who is the member of staff overseeing this. Students are expected to arrange their own work experience placement and this must be indicated on the Bude letter reply slip and returned to the School. Students will then need to liaise with the Careers Advisor giving all the relevant information of their proposed work experience placement.
