Information

Concert and Festival Attendance

Everyone involved in groups is expected to perform in ALL concerts and festivals. We have worked hard this year with NMPAT and other Schools to avoid concert clashes but if there is a clash between a school concert and an NMPAT group rehearsal, the **school concert takes priority**. On concert evenings, everyone needs to be in school by 6:30 p.m.

Not all bands/groups will be in every concert. Details will be put on the Music page of the school website, emailed out, displayed around the Music Department and on our twitter feed (@NSBMusicDep).

It is expected that everyone takes responsibility for practising and improving their performances of pieces being worked on between rehearsals.

Absence from rehearsals

Please let the band director know, either by email or in person, if you are unavailable for any rehearsal as far in advance as possible.

If you are off school ill, please ask Reception to also let the Music Team know when your parent contacts school.

Often there is a clash between practices for sport and music rehearsals. This is not something new and has been successfully resolved over the years by alternating attendance. However, this must be agreed in advance with the band director so that everyone knows what is happening and can prepare accordingly.

Instrumental Lessons & Vocal Tuition 2022 – 2023

We offer a wide range of instrument lessons at Northampton School *for Boys*. Lessons are mainly in groups in Years 7 & 8 except for drum kit, piano and vocal tuition. Individual lessons can be booked in year 7 & 8 depending on ability. All lessons (except piano - 30 minutes) last for 20 minutes each and are rotated on a weekly basis throughout the day that the teacher is in school, so that the student does not miss the same school lesson. The intention is to offer 30 lessons per year.

The subsidised charge for band/orchestral instruments will be £165 per year for group tuition, and vocal tuition will be £330 per year for individual lessons. **Full price lessons would be £204 and £408 respectively.** The charges for piano/jazz piano (individual lessons) will be £600, drum kit (individual lessons) will be £472, and guitar (group) will be £236.

Lessons are individual in year 9 and above. **Full price lessons should be £408**, but with our subsidised charge for band/orchestral instruments and vocal tuition the price will be £330 per year. The charges for piano/jazz piano will be £600, and drum kit and guitar will be £472.

The total amount due will be put on ParentPay and should be cleared in one payment, or in instalments: 50% by the end of term 2 (Christmas) and the balance by the end of Term 4 (Easter).

Please note that there is no reduction if lessons are given up during the course of the year. The full amount will still be due, as we have to book Music Service teachers for a whole year in advance.

There is a fee remission of 50% for years 9-11 for those families who meet the criteria; there is also a fee remission in place through the 16-19 Bursary Scheme for Years 12 & 13, for those families who meet the criteria and where studying curriculum music. More information is available from the Music Office.

<u>All</u> students who take lessons will also be allocated to one or more performance/vocal groups, dependent on ability; for drum kit this will include a percussion ensemble. This is <u>not optional</u> and forms part of their instrumental tuition programme/contract.

Please note that if pupils regularly miss ensembles without prior notification, lesson fees for that period will be charged at the full price rather than the current subsidised rate. Parents will be notified if nonattendance becomes a regular occurrence.

It has had great success at fund raising and also helping to organise concerts and other musical events within the school and local community. <u>All</u> money raised is used to enhance both curricular and extra-curricular music making by the purchase of music, instruments and music technology resources. Musical events provisionally planned for this year will include five school concerts, several Jazz @ The Cripps performances, National Festival competitions and Masterclasses on many different instruments - all subject to Covid regulations.

As a member you will receive full information of all musical events during the year with regular updates via email, priority booking and reduced rates for most concerts. For the school year 2022-23 membership details and costs are as follows: Individual £10 – entitles you to one discounted ticket plus one other per concert, NSB Family (having students currently at the school) £20, Patron £35, Sponsor £70 – two discounted tickets plus up to four others per concert. Patrons and Sponsors are mentioned in each concert programme, and Sponsors will receive two complimentary tickets to one of the Christmas concerts. Please note that ALL memberships will be for one year only, including that for Patrons and Sponsors, and run from September to July. Membership cards or confirmation emails, along with concert details, will be sent out early in September.

If your son/daughter is likely to be involved in any musical activities, we strongly recommend you join **Friends of NSB Music** as all our concerts are over-subscribed and the priority booking will normally ensure ticket availability.

The AGM and first committee meeting is planned for September. The committee meets about four times per year and would particularly welcome new members from parents of the younger students. We rely heavily on the **Friends** to help organise raffles for each concert, as well as the snack and refreshment stall at National Festival Regionals.
