A FACT ABOUT EMPLOYMENT

In 2024, 87.6% of working age (16-64 years old) graduates (a graduate is someone who has completed degree level study) were in employment compared to 68.0% of non-graduates.

67.9% of working age (16-64 years old) graduates were in high-skilled employment compared to 23.7% of non-graduates.

Diagnosed with autism at a young age, Grandin faced challenges related to sensory sensitivities and social communication difficulties.

Despite these obstacles, her innovative thinking led to the development of more humane livestock facilities, revolutionizing practices in animal welfare and autism awareness.

Grandin's career includes extensive research, teaching, and advocacy work that continues to influence both the agriculture industry and autism community.

Her life's work has been to understand her own autistic mind, and to share that knowledge with the world, aiding in the treatment of individuals with the condition.
