There are concerns around the availability of STEM skills in the UK workforce. 49% of engineering and technology businesses report difficulties with recruitment because of skills shortages. This makes STEM a great area to focus your development as you'll be in demand!

SUCCESS STORIES

A flagship employment programme for SEND learners has won a year's extension after hitting its recruitment target.

An extra £1.5 million has been handed to organisations delivering the Department for Education's supported internships programme after ministers declared at least 4,500 learners took part in the scheme in the last year.

Supported internships provide 16 to 25 year olds with education, health and care plans (EHCPs) with bespoke learning, a dedicated job coach and work placements of 6 to 12 months.

The evaluation report found almost half (47%) of interns had a job six months after completion, which is great because securing employment was a "primary goal" for participants of the scheme.
