National Festival of Music for Youth

Following the Regional event in March, I am delighted to tell you that **Metalworks** has been invited to take part in this year's **National Festival of Music for Youth in Birmingham** during the first week of July.

Metalworks is scheduled to perform in **Town Hall, Birmingham, on Friday 5 July** at 10.29 a.m. Everyone who is a member of the ensemble is expected to take part. This is our last performance of the year and will follow on from our final school concert performance on **Thursday 27 June – 'Summer Fiesta'**.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 7:45 a.m. and should arrive back at school by 2:15 p.m. when students will be expected to return to class in school uniform. Casual clothes can be worn to travel in but please bring black concert clothes to perform in, along with plenty of food, or money to buy some with, and water.

As the County Youth Concert Band and County Youth Big Band are also in Birmingham that day students in those groups will stay with Miss Coles and return on the NMPAT coach after their performances.

Rehearsals will continue to run as usual throughout the examination period although Year 11, 12 & 13 examinations must take priority. We would, however, appreciate members of those year groups attending as often as their examination/revision schedule allows them to.

Commitment and responsibility are key elements that ensure high standards of performance so if you cannot make a rehearsal please mark this on the schedule attached.
